STATISTICAL TABLES

Judge Froessel stepped down from the Court after participating in the decisions of December 31, 1962. He was replaced by Judge Scileppi who commenced participation in the first decisions of January 1963. For that reason Tables A, B and C present statistics for each composition of the Court separately. Enumerations appearing at the left of a colon apply to the Court when its composition included Judge Froessel and enumerations at the right apply to the new composition including Judge Scileppi.
